Extract From Lynne O'Quinn letter to her prayer partners

God has answered another huge prayer . . . **Monday morning we were invited into an elementary school where we got to spend ALL day with 4th, 5th and 6th graders!** We sang Christian songs, played Christian games, played ball, jumped rope, taught them English, etc. At the very end of the day, I got to hand **out 67 Thai books** and **read the book aloud** while a young girl read the book in Thai.

They all sat there and listened to every word and thanked me for the book! It was read in front of the school principal and one of the male teachers. (I was either going to read the book or get thrown out but we opted to trust in Jesus and take our chance!) Again, **"Shout for joy, you heavens and earth rejoice!"** The teacher took a book for his grandchildren and the principal wanted a picture with us and asked **"Were we coming back ALL day tomorrow to spend it with the 1st, 2nd and 3rd graders?!"** Yes, Lord, Yes!!

And again, **"Mountains break into joyful shouts!"** **14 of these students came to John Middlewood's tonight from 6:00-8:00PM for more Bible stories, songs and games!** (They are coming back every night this week!)

"For the Lord has comforted His people and He will have compassion on His afflicted ones" We have been invited to another school for **Wednesday and Thursday ALL day!!** There is just no stopping God when the prayers of His people are lifted up in faith!

Saturday, we have an all day Bible school planned for children. Please continue in prayer throughout this week and weekend and for all God has done, is doing and will do. And to think, when we came to Thailand we wondered what exactly we were going to do. **Isaiah 6:8 "Lord, here I am!"** Trust me, He has plenty for us all to do!

Today God sent us to another school with about 50 Buddhist children. The ages were kindergarten to sixth grade. Again, we were allowed to share Jesus all day long through songs, games, stories and our love. As if that was not enough, God sent a news announcer to eat lunch with us at the school. After lunch, he videoed me, Edie and Shan and we got to tell why we were there . . . to share God's love and Jesus! As if that was not enough, he then taped the children singing, "Jesus Loves Me" with sign language. This really confirmed to me how small a box we place God in. We have our ideas of what we can or can't do when God can do anything He so chooses.

And tonight . . . we added 3 more new students at our Bible study time. This brings the total to 17 children! (Every night!) Tonight, the children (ages 6 to college, boys and girls) were all there waiting on us. Several young girls nearly knocked me down running to hug me. I asked one them how she was doing and her beautiful, radiant face looked up at me and she said, "I am happy!" How do you not fall on your knees before I AM and cry tears of joy and love? And tonight as they left they hugged so tight I could barely breathe and in the sign language we had taught them signed:

"I love you . . .

I love Jesus."
