The village of Teupasenti is a city approximately 22,000 people. A 5:30 am walk through the cobblestone and dirt streets provided an enlightening view of the Honduras early morning routine. As the day unfolded, sounds of a busy village came alive with the coming and going of the village residents.



The simply built homes have no attics or closets for storage and some are used as business storefronts. A week of living in an unfamiliar lifestyle has replaced the comforts of North Carolina but given us valuable memories, for sure.

Our new friends are sincere and passionate about their love for Jesus. They have so little materialistically but their warm embrace is worth so much more. The church members have such a passion for Christ and are eager to share it with

everyone.

The residents of the village are very friendly and ready to welcome us into their homes.



After 2½ days of POR FE (FAITH) training at Iglesia Evangelica El Eden Church we went out into the village in teams. The seven groups, armed with a new approach to witnessing, scattered across the village to share the salvation plan. One by one, God kept providing unbelievable moments to celebrate. It is amazing to see the determination in the group to speak to as many people as possible even in the rain. The Honduran rainy season hasn't broken our spirits instead we have experienced God's "Showers of Blessings." Bibles and witness bracelets were presented to those that made personal commitments for Jesus.

Many tools are used in faith training to help equip the students with several ideas to use while presenting the plan of salvation. "Sharing Jesus Around the World" is a children's book that was penned by Lynne O'Quinn, which simply explains the plan of salvation for a child. This book was presented to the class on Wednesday at 12:00. We took a break for lunch and during this time a 13-year-old boy wandered into the gate of the church. One of the students approached him with the book. With the help of another student they were able to lead this boy to Christ using this tool less than one hour after it was presented to them. How amazing is our God?

Tonight the revival continued at the village park and to our expectations the attendance increased from Sunday evening of 30 to Wednesday evening 135. Wow! What does God have in store for tomorrow? There is no doubt the Holy Spirit was present as we heard a concert from a local family of musicians. Sam, our missionary host, sang songs from his heart and Rick presented a spirit filled message of encouragement and inspiration for the village of Teupasenti.
